Dear SSPS Community,

What a week it has been full of thank you and farewell events! This week we've celebrated Year 6 Graduation, our final School Council meeting for the year and the Parent & Carer Helpers' Thank You Breakfast. We are so grateful for the support we receive and know that this helps us to be a great school with a strong sense of community.

On Tuesday this week most of our Year 6 students spent the day at their 2019 secondary schools, as part of the state wide transition program. After a big day getting to know their secondary schools, the Year 6 students arrived back at Spensley Street for Graduation dinner. They entered a beautifully decorated space, sat at round tables and ate a delicious meal with their teachers, including many past SSPS teachers! A huge thank you goes out to all of the parents and teachers who went above and beyond to make the night so special.

There has been some significant work happening during the last week in the STEAM Room. Workers onsite, machinery manifested, a crane arrived, steel is going up! It is beginning to look like something is taking shape! This is exciting! The work will continue through the school holidays with an expected completion date in late March.

A reminder that on Monday 16th December, students will spend time with their 2020 home group and teacher. Students will bring home a letter communicating their class teacher and area that day. The purpose of the morning is for all students to feel positive and confident about the year ahead. Class placement is a complex task. We take into account factors including the children's learning and social needs, friendships and working relationships. Class numbers and year level numbers also impact the process, especially in a multi-age school.

In 2020 there will be considerable changes for many staff and students across the school. The majority of these changes are related to staff moving physical areas along with the change in home group structures in P-2 and 5-6. A full class and area list will be emailed out on Monday to go along with the class placement letters children will receive.

I know some students and parents may feel uneasy about class placement and the idea of change is challenging for some. It's important for you to know that children generally settle quickly into their new homegroups, or a changed location and we work to create a supportive environment for students in this transition.

There will also be some staffing changes in 2020. At the end of this year we say goodbye to Fabienne Parker and Lucas Kilmartin. Fabienne joined SSPS at the beginning of this year teaching P-2. Lucas joined SSPS in 2018 and has worked in the year 5-6 team. We thank both Fabienne and Lucas for their contribution to our school and community and wish them both well in their future teaching careers.

We welcome new class teachers Tanaya Boag, Emily Fintelman and Erica St Clair to the SSPS team as well as Toby Russo, a new class teacher and Learning Specialist. We are very much looking forward to them joining our school community in 2020.


